## **The Cork Airport Route Support Scheme 2005 – One Year Extension to Scheme**

The Cork Airport Route Support Scheme 2005 discounts on a number of routes from Cork Airport are due to reach the end of their discounted period in 2010. In an effort to stabilise the market in the current economic environment, Cork Airport will offer these routes one further year of route support at the current rate of discount being enjoyed in year 5.

The following stipulations apply to this scheme:

- The Route Support Scheme 2005 – One Year Extension will only apply to services which commenced in 2005 and would cease to enjoy Route Support Discounts between January 1<sup>st</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup> 2010, namely:
  - Liverpool
  - Newcastle
  - Rome
- Only the discount pertaining to relevant airport charges in Year 5 of the original 2005 Route Support Scheme will be available to the airline operating the existing service.
- The route must continue to be operated by the Airline which has operated it up to now.
- The route must continue to operate on a year round basis.
- The route must continue to be a non stop service from Cork Airport.
- The routes must continue to operate year round at the following minimum frequencies:
  - Liverpool – daily
  - Newcastle – twice weekly
  - Rome – twice weekly
- The airline must have the traffic rights to fly the proposed route/schedule.
- The schedule timings proposed and operated have been reviewed and approved by the airport authority and any slot change requests issued by the airport authority have been fully complied with.

All Terms and Conditions applying to the Cork Airport **Route Support Scheme (RSS) 2005** will also apply to this extension of the scheme.
